



Functionality Scoring Criteria

ANCCE March 2010 RULES

For Stallion Sections 8, 10 and 12

Nothing has changed in the pattern of the exercise. The scoring criteria is different.

Whips are allowed in four-year-old sections only (7&8).

Snaffle bit required, on single or double reins. Saddle- Spanish or English.

Taken into account: generosity, regularity & extent of the walk, trot & canter.

Impulsion. Stepping under of the hind legs, and balance. Maintaining the cadence.

Generosity of movements going forward.

Be sure to read other "rider" rules of ANCCE premium.

Potential points

1	MEDIUM WALK	20
2	EXTENDED WALK	20
3	WORKING TROT	20
4	EXTENDED TROT	20
5	WORKING CANTER	20
6	EXTENDED CANTER	20
7	BREED FIDELITY	10
8	OVERALL IMPRESSION	10

TOTAL point potential is 140, but only 25% is taken and added to the morphology score.

The highest functionality score is thus 35 points (25% of 140).
